Pokhara, Loo Niva conducted two days “Annual Review & Planning workshop 2015” programme on 25th Dec to 26th Dec, 2015 in Hotel Landmark, Pokhara, Kaski. This workshop aimed on the achievements, challenges, learning’s, recommendations, identification of the good practices and project activities review in depth with 27 participants. **Mr. Bhola Dahal & Mr. Narendra Dangol** facilitated the annual performance of Loo Niva incorporating both an organizational

management level and Project performance.

ESP, EGP and CFE projects activities accomplished in 2015 were reviewed and discussed on the major achievements, challenges and learning. Similarly, the project activities plans for 2016 were developed by active participation of all the staff members. Executive Director expected the clear implementation guideline for the year 2016 according to the detail discussion of planning group.

Refresher training on career education

Four facilitator and six Loo Niva staffs were capacitated on career counseling and life skills, coordination process, facilitation skill, tools and methods which can be used in the commu-

nity awareness class. Participants prepared action plan for career education classes to conduct in different community at VDC level. District Project Coordinator **Gyan Bhakta Maharjan** was the facilitator in the training program.

Mr. Yagyaraj Bokati, District Finance Officer presented the planned project activities for February 2016 to July 2016. The meeting agreed and provided approval to conduct project in Siddheshwor, Bishalpur, Bashuling, Rodidewal and Shreekedar VDCs of Baitadi district.

Refresher Training for Youth Facilitators

Lalitpur, Loo Niva organized two days “Refresher for youth facilitation training” program in Gimdi, South Lalitpur from 27th Jan to 28th Jan, 2016. 18 youths participated and were capacitated on the new skills and knowledge of the facilitation skill. They reviewed on the past events and with new learnings developed plan and action of community awareness class for

2016. **Mr. Bishnu Gopal Dangol** facilitated the whole programme session. The training was aimed to improve and contribute to the community development and education governance program. It provided knowledge on education laws, rules, and acts to all the participants and thereby uplift the facilitation skills of volunteers as well.

Warm Blanket Support to Save the Life from Cold

Lalitpur, Loo Niva distributed blankets to 25 students’ family of Chandidevi Primary School, Dukuchaap to protect the children from cold on 16th February with the support of Arabia School Finland. The Chandidevi school is one of the project area community of Loo Niva

situated in Dukuchhap, the most affected area by the earthquake. Teachers selected most vulnerable and back warded children and family who are living with difficulties to fulfill even their basic daily needs. The school was also supported by multipurpose printer for official use.

The catchment area of the school is community of Danuwaars who are enlisted in the marginalized community and most vulnerable .160 houses of the school catchment area destroyed by earthquake, one person injured and two school buildings and one toilet was dam-

aged. Majority of people in devastating area are living in temporary tin made shelter with hardship in the winter season. Life is much difficult for the most poor family who cannot afford and fulfill for their basic requirements.

nator and secretary from the participants. The watch group developed action plan for their respected districts. **Mr. Narendra Dangol**, Executive Director presented the information of Education Watch. Facilitator and Activist **Mr. Milan Raj Dharel** oriented on work method and regular monitoring sample selection method.
