



## *Provision of educational materials to the students*

Loo Niva Child Concern Group had provided education and educational materials i.e copy, pencil, school dresses, bags and other stationary materials to those who were economically back warded of its working area i.e. South Laltipur, Thuladurlug, Gimdi, Asrang. The main objective of the program to increased



attendance rate of student in school and increase their learning achievement. The materials were handed over to 150 children by related ward presidents, Ram Krishna Acharya of Thuladurlung, Nawarai Sanjal of Gimdi and Lal Bahadur Bhonjan of Ashrang ward.

The annual report of the organization has shown that children from different family who were facing such kind of

problems were provided educational support and contributed in increasing quality in education and learning achievement.

## *Port yard Class (Pidhi Kakshya) started at village*

In total 27 community awareness classes have been carried out during April to June 2019. Main objectives of the program was to empower and strengthen knowledge to the parents on state facilities, role and responsibilities of SMC/PTA in school. The program was jointly organized with the local governments. All the ward chairs of three project wards took the sessions on current education structure, system and policies which are adapted from the local government. In total 381 parents took participate in the program where 29 participants were marginalized, disabled 11,



1 dalit, 183 janajati and 157 were brahman/chhetri.

This program helped to build the good relation between parents and schools. It helped to increase parent's involvement in school activities and positive environment at home also. This program has expected that these kinds of activities contribute in enhancing quality education in school and positive impacts on other school activities which contribute in increasing accountable and inclusiveness in school.

### *Awareness Classes to Students*



Mr. Manoj Dulal, SM of Gimdi ward has organized four awareness classes to the students of four schools of Gimdi ward. The main aim of the classes was to orient the students on state facilities on education, positive behaviors with CwDs and excluded children in Schools. All these events were accomplished in the month of April 2019. In total 113 students were benefited from the program and they are going to share their learnings among their friends. Social mobilizers of Ashrang and Thuladurlung have finalized their planning of awareness classes and are planning to conduct from the month of July 2019.

### *Village level child clubs conference and planning workshops*



Village level child club conference event has been accomplished in the month of May 2019 at all project wards – Ashrang, Gimdi and Thuladurlung. The program has got success to form the ward level child club network and also prepared the annual plan for this year 2019. The program was facilitated by our SM in their respective areas. All the elected ward members were present in the program. The ward office registered the child club and also endorsed their plans in annual plan of ward office. 53 children from Ashrang took participate in the program.

### *Child clubs and Child club networks reformation and support in activities*

It has supported to reform 7 school-based child clubs and 2 ward level network. All the child clubs got new leadership for this year 2019. All the child club members are elected in democratic process (taking consent from all participants). The program was facilitated by Loo Niva SMs in their respective

wards. All the SMs has also supported to prepare the annual plan of child club on same day.



15 events of the child clubs have been supported during the months of May and June through child club support activities. In total 862 (boys -442 & 440 girls) children have engaged in these events.

Child club members are excited as it has provided plat from to expose their talents. They said this kind of platform motivate them to better in their academic performance also.

### ***Project Advisory Committee Formation***

It has formed municipal project advisory committee (MPAC) committee in Bagmati Rural Municipality on 23 May 2019 with the presence of chairperson, vice chair, ward chairs, child club members and teachers of Rural Municipality. The program was jointly organized with Patan CBR.

The project advisor committee forming program was formally started by representative of Patan CBR Mr. Ram Kumar Kuwar with warm welcome. Program Manager of Loo Niva Mr.

Sant Ram Dangol presented and openly discussed about the value and objective of MPAC and its role and responsibilities. The project advisor committee formation process was started by vice president Mrs. Ranjana Ghimire (Timalsina) and formed MPAC committee of 15 members.

Senior Program Officer of Loo Niva Mr. Chiri Kaji Dangol and project officer of Patan CBR Mr. Ram Kumar Kuwar presented about the annual plan of 2019. All the participants actively participated in the open discussion on annual plan of both organizations. The program helped to collect the suggestion for the quality implementation and commitment for joint venture in coming days as well.



At the end of the program, the meeting has decided to conduct monitoring visit at the project location of both organizations. At last ward president Mr. Bir Bahadur Lopchan concluded that the program and gave vote of thanks to Loo Niva and Patan CBR for its accountable towards local government.
