### National Consultation Program on Final Examination of School Education, Publication of Result and New Academic Session



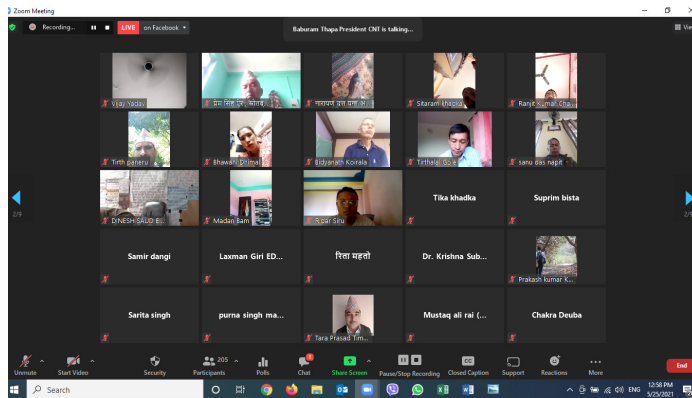

Lalitpur, Education Watch Group (EWG) in collaboration with Loo Niva Child Concern Group, Interpedia Finland and Ministry of Foreign Affairs Finland organized a national consultation program on final examination of school education, publishing or result and new academic session.

All the educational institutions have been closed after the lockdown started from 29 April 2021 again. The second wave struck the country with more transmissible variants, many children, young people have been infected. It has been a great challenge for all over the world. The education sector also faces huge challenges and brought lots of confusions about how to conduct the final examination, publish result and run a new academic session. Education watch group conducted a national consultation program to have national level consultation on these issues.

#### Objective of the program

- To provide the concrete suggestions to the government for conducting the final exam, result publication & new academic year after adequate discussions on how to conduct the examination in the midst of the ban & how to address the group of students who are not covered by the alternative education system.
- To discuss how to publish the result of final exam conducted by the school in the lockdown period & share it with the stakeholders.
- Extensive discussion on how to start a new academic year to ensure that all school aged children get an education in the lockdown will be continued & disseminate the information among stakeholders.
- Ensuring continuity of safe, adequate and appropriate educational and social learning and development of children.
